

**MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING**  
**BETWEEN**  
**Faculty of Art and Architecture and the Kurdistan Studies Institute (KSI), University of**  
**Kurdistan (UoK), Iran**  
**AND**  
**Faculty of Humanities and the Department of Cross-Cultural and Regional Studies,**  
**University of Copenhagen, Denmark**

The *Faculty of Art and Architecture* and the *Kurdistan Studies Institute (KSI)*, University of Kurdistan (UoK), and the *Department of Cross-Cultural and Regional Studies* and its affiliate project the *Danish Archaeological Expedition to Iran and Iraq (DAEII)*, University of Copenhagen, Denmark, declare their willingness to establish relations of collaboration and to develop academic research and cultural interchange between the institutions.

### **1- SCOPE OF THE PARTICIPATION**

The areas of collaboration fall within the scope of *archaeological research and cultural heritage*, and include, subject to mutual consent, academic scholarly, teaching and research activities offered at either institution that both sides feel contribute to the fostering and development of the co-operative relationship between the two institutions.

### **2- GENERAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION**

Funds will be sought from appropriate sources, subject to mutual approval by the parties for such activities as:

1. Research collaboration in the areas of archaeological research and cultural heritage related to the activities conducted by DAEII.
2. Joint publications and workshops related to DAEII's activities.
3. Informal training for students and researchers related to DAEII's activities.

### **3- PROMOTION OF RESEARCH COLLABORATIONS**

3.1 A member involved in the research collaboration will annually at the University of Kurdistan make a presentation or report (oral or written or both), on a subject related to the joint research activities of that year. In the absence of activities or due to hindrances, the presentation may be held at another time or place.
