Application Requirement in General:

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences under the rules of University of Kurdistan accept the International Students. Either International Students must take 340 hours Persian Language Training Courses in the Center for Persian Language Training to Non-Persian Speakers of the University of Kurdistan, or they can take SAMFA exam, which is a standardized exam for Persian Language proficiency.

Services of the Faculty for International Students: All Academic members, staff, and laboratory technicians attempt to give the best services to International students during each semester. The faculty provides a very friendly environment for all students such that it supports all students' activities.
