



ABOUT The Faculty

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences works with the mission of educating an efficient, thoughtful, entrepreneurial human capital within the framework of a strategic plan on education, research and social responsibility. The Faculty currently has 11 departments and 65 full-time faculty members with 49 Assistant professors, 14 associate professors and 2 professors conducting undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral activities in the faculty. The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences has 2940 students in 34 programs, with 191 international students have the highest number of college students. Holding annually national and international conferences, publishing 8 scientific journals, activities of scientific and national associations, holding numerous specialized meetings, exchanging more than 10 students and professors with universities around the world, establishing a Family Pathology and Education Research Center, study projects with institutions outside the university and the initial steps to establish law and sports clinics, as well as financial and investment advisory centers and the establishment of a new college are the other programs.

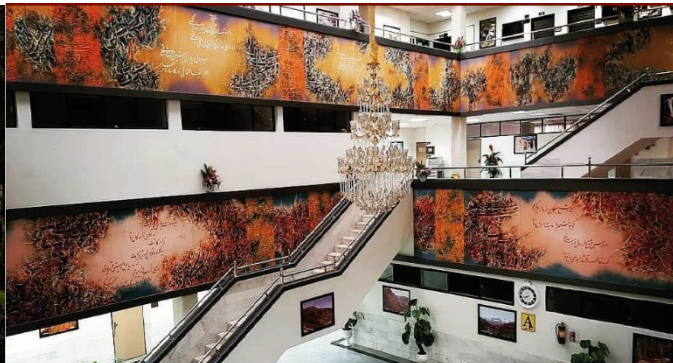

Application Requirement in General:

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences under the rules of University of Kurdistan accept the International Students. Either International Students must take 340 hours Persian Language Training Courses in the Center for Persian Language Training to Non-Persian Speakers of the University of Kurdistan, or they can take SAMFA exam, which is a standardized exam for Persian Language proficiency.

Services of the Faculty for International Students:

All Academic members, staff, and laboratory technicians attempt to give the best services to International students during each semester. The faculty provides a very friendly environment for all students such that it supports all students' activities.
